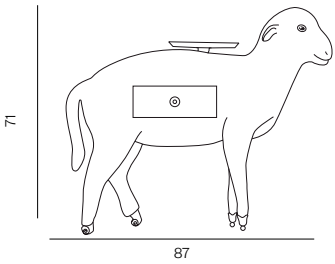


COMPONENTS, MATERIALS & FINISHES

Stued lamb, elaborated with a technique by a taxidermist.
Sheep skin with hair (butchered for meat consumption).
Internal metal structure.
Stued with polyurethane sponge.
Glass eyes.
Drawer and table top in solid varnished walnut wood.
Hooves in gilt solid bronze.



FINISHES

Natural hair colour and or dyed in black.
Walnut Wood varnished in natural matt.
Hooves in solid gold bronze.

DIMENSIONS AND WEIGHT

87x26x(h*).71cm. approx. - 10Kg /22 lbs

PACKAGING

Box in treated pine. Piece internally protected with foam air wrap and sponge.

MAINTENANCE

The lamb has been dried and stued in accord with current regulations. This piece has been treated with an adequate product however, it must be cleaned with a cotton cloth, at least once a week, removing the dirt in it's fur.
It is recommended that a damp cotton cloth be used to clean the lamb with a mineral essence, either C or F (perchlorethylene), which can be purchased from any drugstore.
It is recommended that a vaporised insecticide be applied at least twice a year to combat moth larvae.
It is important that the product is not directly exposed to the sun or radiation and humid places (between 30%-60% would be the correct range).
